

HOW DOES THE AMAZON BIT WORK?

Your book is set up on Amazon as part of the package you have purchased. Your book can be searched for on Amazon (as you would search for anything) or there is a link to your book through our own bookshop: www.inkbookshop.com.

The price listed on Amazon is set by Amazon to cover the print/packaging costs. Little Thinking Publishing makes just under Ip per book sale, which we use to cover admin costs as and when they arise.

There are no royalties to be made on your book as no rights have been signed over - the book and its contents belong to you and your young author.

If you would prefer to set up your own KDP account and list your book for yourself, you are absolutely free to do this, and we will provide you with the print-ready files at no extra cost (we have made them anyway to order your ten copies).

If the book becomes popular (or your young author is a whizz at marketing!), you are free to take this option as well. Just let us know, and we will remove the book from our KDP store. You can then list your book at whatever price you want.

Something to note: When you order from Amazon, they print the book on demand (known as POD). The initial 10 books that you purchased with your package are not printed by Amazon, but by Book Printing UK, which we use for all our printing.
